

Umbrella Instructions:

- 1. Cut out both circles and set smaller one aside. I used scalloped edge scissors for the large circle.
- 2. Fold large circle in half and then in half again and then in half again (3 times)
- 3. Cut off a tiny part of the tip of the cone to make a hole in the center of the circle.
- 4. Open up the circle and glue a toothpick to each of the folds on the non-printed side of the circle, making sure they do not overlap but meet the edge of the hole in the center. Let the toothpicks dry.
- 5. Fold the umbrella in half, in half, in half, and in half again (4 times) to shape it.
- 6. Cut a piece 2 inch piece of tissue paper, crumble into a loose ball and glue it to the tip of a skewer.
- 7. Glue the tissue paper ball part to the underside of the umbrella, right on top of the hole.
- 8. Glue the small circle onto the patterned top of the umbrella at the center to cover the hole.
- 9. Cut the skewer to desired size.
- 10. Attach Skewer Umbrella to the corner of the basket. (I attached it to the inside)
